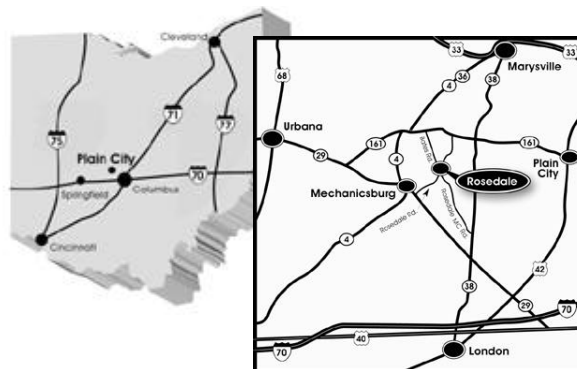
TOBY TRAVIS
